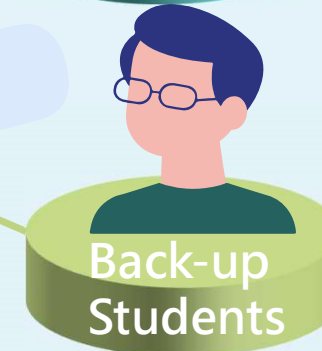
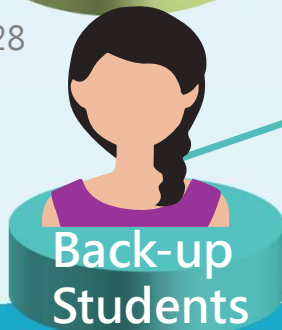
About the Program

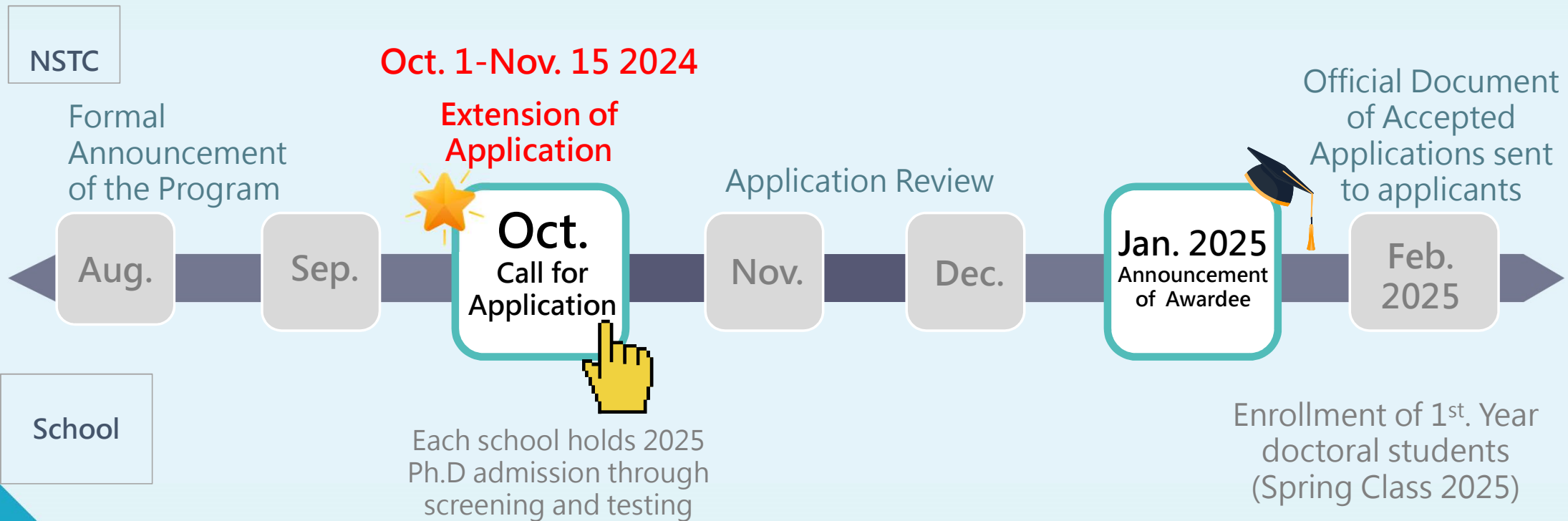
