	a.	The student attendsfor at least 1 year, and also attends STUST	•	
		for at least 1 year.		
	b.	The student completes all required courses and earns credits approved by both		
		universities		
	c.	The student finishes a thesis (dissertation) within the stipulated time period and	l	
		passes all required examinations at both universities.		
	d.	The student pays (all required tuition and fees) at both universities.		
	e. Students will be awarded separate degree certificates from both their home			
		university and the host university, once the specific requirements of each		
		university are fulfilled.		
3.	To enter the program, the student must be a registered full-time postgraduate in either			

- of the above mentioned unit.
- 4. To apply for admission to the program, the student must complete an application form, attach all necessary documents and send them to his/her home university, and then to the host university for approval before the deadline.
- 5. All students admitted to the program must arrive at the host university before a set deadline and follow all school regulations. Any student that wishes to take an extended leave of absence, for any reason, must have the approval of both and STUST beforehand.
- 6. Eligible faculty members of both universities can act as co-advisors of students in the

- program. The roles of co-advisers in regard to research, the writing and publishing of theses (dissertations), exams, and other related matters are as stated in the Co-advising Arrangement.
- 7. This agreement may be revised, but only with the consent of both universities. Any proposals for alteration of this agreement must be submitted to the concerned parties in such a manner as to allow sufficient time for consideration and for mutual understanding to be reached.
